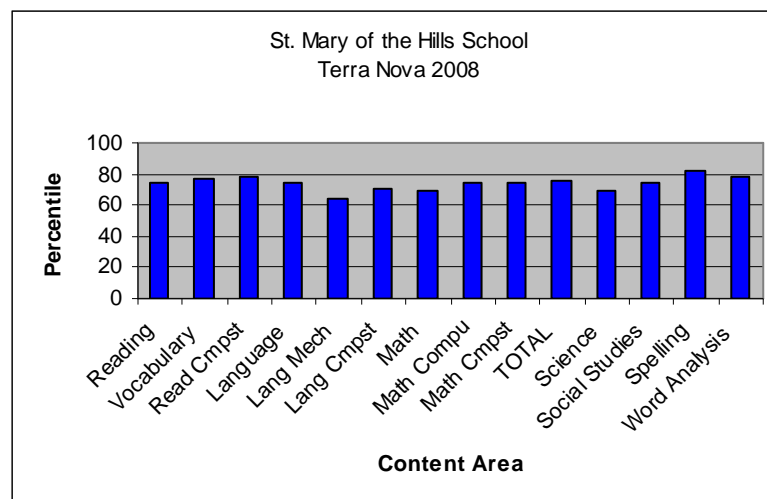
## Academic Excellence

### OUR PRINCIPALS AND FACULTY

St. Mary of the Hills PreK-Grade 4 Principal offers 15 years of leadership experience and a master's degree in educational leadership from Bridgewater State College. St. Mary of the Hills Grade 5-8 Principal offers 5 years of leadership experience and a certificate of advanced graduate studies in educational leadership from Cambridge College. Our faculty members have an average of 12 years of teaching experience and are certified in the state of Massachusetts with the Department of Education. They are professionals who seek to share the love of learning with their students. The results of our faculty's dedication and experience can be seen everyday in our classrooms and in the accomplishments of our students as they move on from St. Mary of the Hills.

### STANDARDIZED SCORES

St. Mary of the Hills students excel at standardized testing and our curriculum meets or exceeds the curriculum frameworks established by the Massachusetts Department of Education. St. Mary of the Hills School students score higher in the content areas of Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies and in their Total Score among Catholic elementary schools in the Archdiocese of Boston. Against the national average, St. Mary of the Hills students score in the 78 percentile in Reading, 71 percentile in Language, and 75 percentile in Math (based on 2008 TerraNova scores).

The mission of Saint Mary of the Hills School is based on the core belief that each child can, through hard work, encouragement and support both at home and school, realize and recognize his or her unique potential. 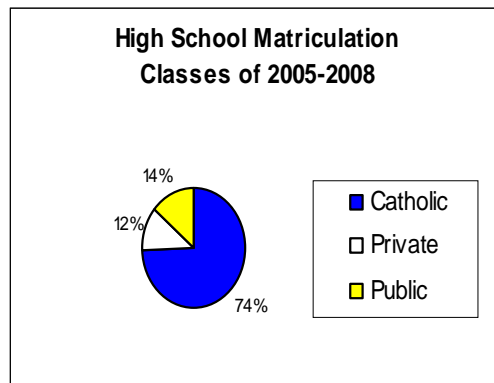
### COMMUNITY SERVICE
